Joint Graduate School involves:

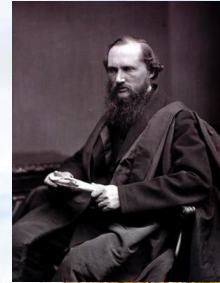

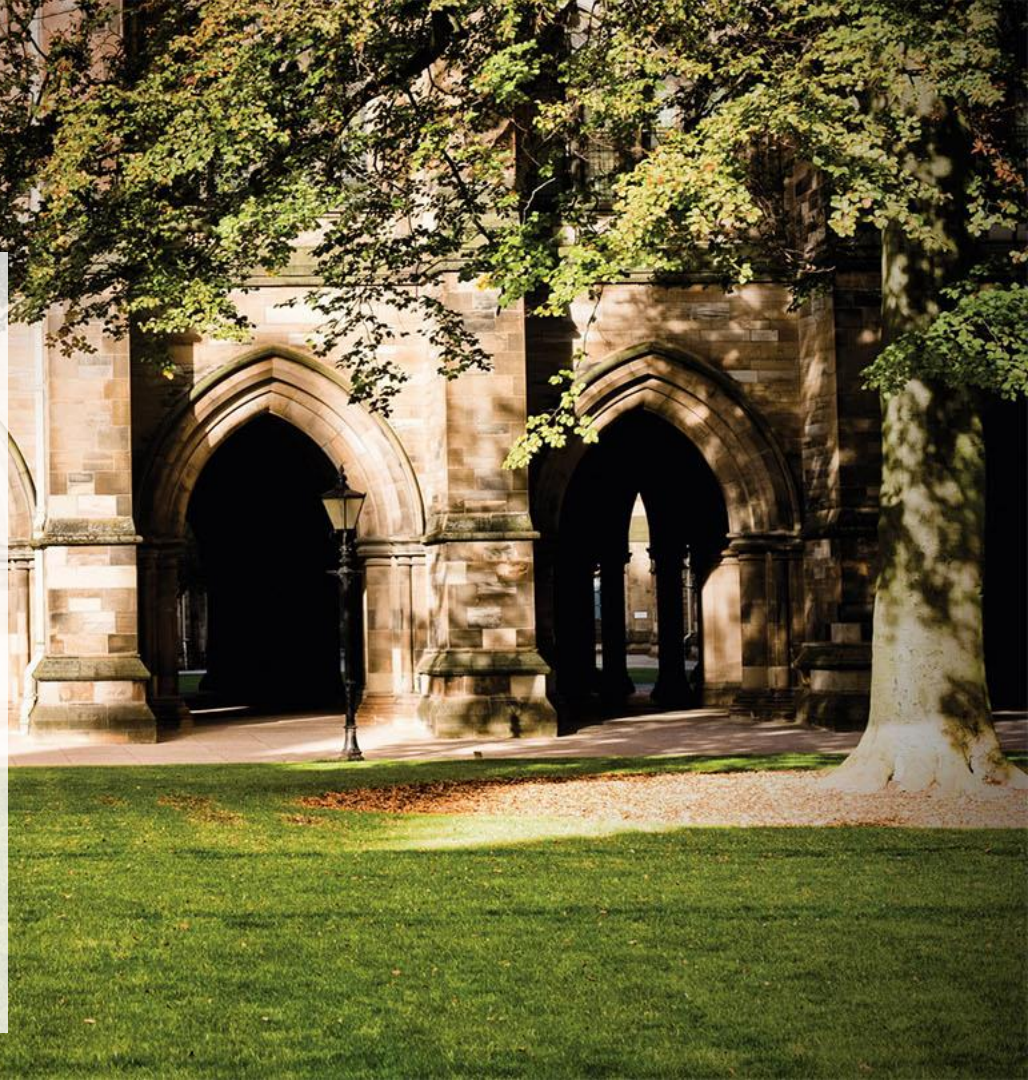
What is the Joint Graduate School?

- **Unique** and innovative collaboration between the Universities of Glasgow and Nankai
- Major Transnational Education (TNE) innovative for the University of Glasgow
- Half of the courses taught by Nankai University academics and half taught by University of Glasgow academics; Glasgow academics travel to Nankai University to deliver postgraduate taught courses
- **Successful JGS students will be awarded a degree from each University**



Why the Summer School

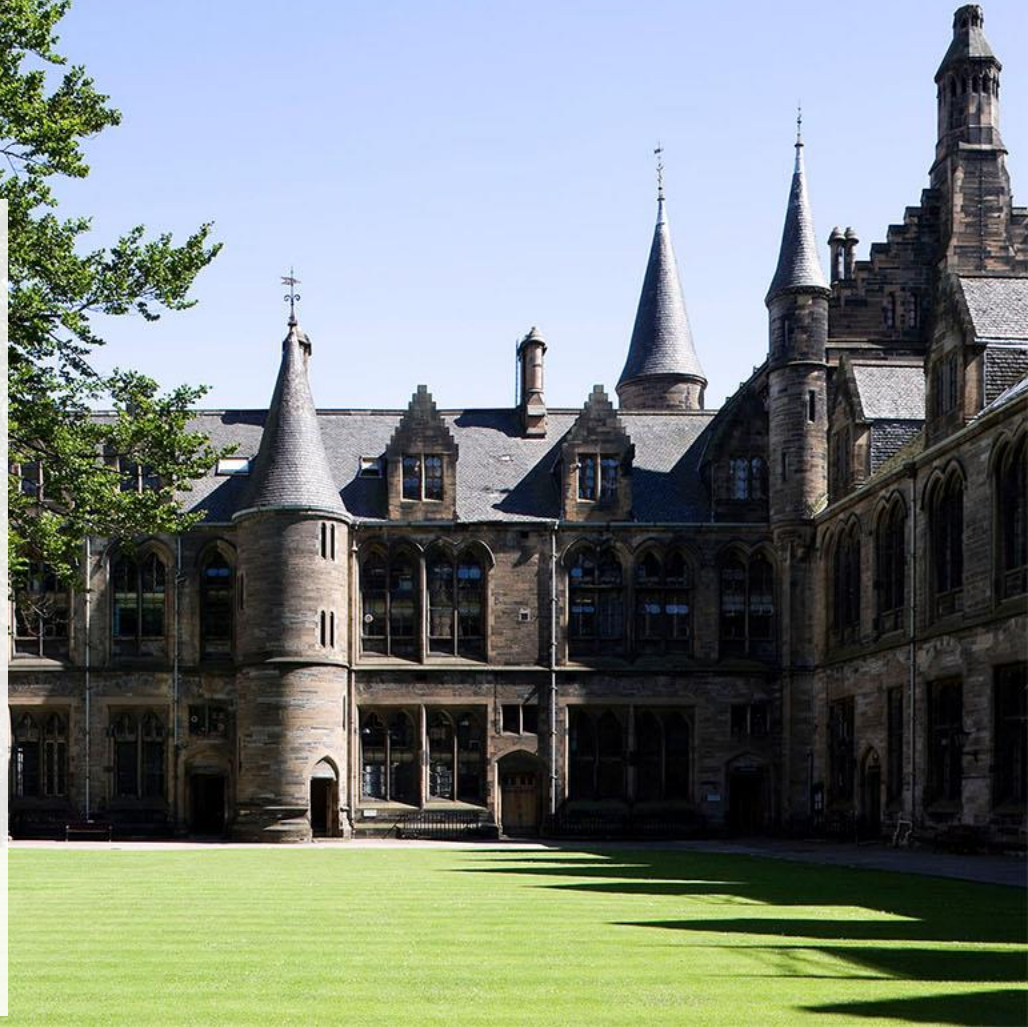
- A Glasgow experience for you
